Our goal is to ensure that all family members and children with disabilities, who walk through our doors, are given an opportunity to imagine renewed possibilities for their child and be provided with a healing environment for families to see the future with hope.

Imprint Hope envisions a world where all children with disabilities are appreciated for their unique talents and provided an opportunity to actualize their full potential.

Objectives

- Educate caregivers on child development, disabilities, proper nutrition, hygiene, and optimal strategies to facilitate the growth and development of their child with a disability.
- Provide one-on-one supportive counseling sessions, daily physical therapy sessions, group counseling, educational classes, and a supportive environment of healing and hope for children with disabilities and their caretaker.
- Provide vital resources (i.e. wheelchairs, braces) and referrals upon discharge to boost the quality of life for all children with disabilities.
- Empower communities to work together on sustainable rehabilitation.



What to Expect at the Imprint Hope Center

Our Center has a number of different rooms, services and seminars that are offered on a rotating basis. We have private services offered to our clients as well as workshops that we open up to the community at large.

Physical Therapy Room - A place where children with disabilities will receive intensive therapy and one on one training with their caregivers.

Training Room - A place where educational seminars will be held for families of children with disabilities. Classes to be offered are as follows –

Parenting Classes:

- Creating a supportive and loving home environment
- Growth and Development of children
- Communication Skills

Hygiene Classes:

- Personal Hygiene
- Homemaking Skills
- Maintaining a clean and sanitized kitchen

- Difference between proteins, vitamins, carbohydrates
- Strategies for building a strong immune system
- Preparing sample diets for children

- Types of disabilities
